Human services careers include roles that support families, children and individuals of all ages as they manage the mental, emotional and practical demands of daily life. Those in human services careers work in a broad spectrum of settings including hospitals, non-profit agencies, nursing homes, childcare centers, government offices, spas, hotels, schools, funeral homes, and schools.
