



Session Title	Description
Program Administrator Workshop	This session will prepare leaders to have conversations addressing district and school-based overall implementation goals. Leaders will understand the tools and settings of the platform and create supporting policies and collateral around usage goals. Leaders will set up the platform to be ready for end-user product training and student usage.
Leaders Data Management and Progress Monitoring	This session will prepare leaders to identify and examine engagement, progress, and achievement data metrics, run key reports, and analyze district- or school-level data, as well as course and individual student data. Leaders will discover how to create targeted goals and implement them on a district and school level. Success strategies for students at the district, school, and classroom levels and learning about data chat-conferencing and establishing a best practice schedule for reporting will be introduced.
Leaders Foundations in the 21st Century Classroom	This session will support leaders by learning about and analyzing student motivation and engagement. Success strategies and specific tools for support and identifying data-driven teaching strategies to address specific learning needs will be highlighted. Hands-on opportunities to plan and implement data routines to track engagement, monitor progress, and measure achievement will leave educators feeling confident accessing reports and interpreting data to make learner-centered and data-informed decisions. *Prerequisite: Data Management and Progress Monitoring I.
Foundations in the 21st Century Classroom	This session analyzes student motivation and engagement. Educators will acquire steps for student-led goal setting and expectations for achievement. Participants will review reporting and progress monitoring tools to analyze data and learn how to implement best practice conferencing.
Management in the 21st Century Classroom	This session delves into implementation goals and how to meet them effectively. Educators will develop and evaluate academic integrity policies and procedures, establish structures and routines to support online learners, and examine data and reports that inform conferencing and successful strategies to guide student progress.
